When using Designer Series Paper, I will coordinate my paper and ink colors to the colors in the paper. Here are the colors used for each set of cards:

Daffodil Afternoon Designer Series Paper: Basic Black, Crushed Curry, Daffodil Delight, Evening Evergreen, Flirty Flamingo, Mint Macaron, Mossy Meadow, Pale Papaya, Pear Pizzazz, Very Vanilla (this paper was only available during Sale-a-Bration 2022)

Flowering Fields Designer Series Paper: Calypso Coral, Evening Evergreen, Fresh Freesia, Highland Heather, Mango Melody, Pear Pizzazz, Petal Pink, Pool Party, Poppy Parade, Pumpkin Pie, Rich Razzleberry, So Saffron, Soft Succulent



Daffodil Pop-Out Swing Card

- Very Vanilla: 5-1/2" x 8-1/2", scored at 4-1/4"
- Very Vanilla: 5-1/4" x 6", scored at 2" and 4"
- Very Vanilla: (2) 1/2" x 4", scored at 2"
- Daffodil Afternoon Designer Series Paper: 4" x 5-1/4"
- Daffodil Afternoon Designer Series Paper: (2) 1-3/4" x 5"

Tulip Pop-Out Swing Card

- Basic White: 5-1/2" x 8-1/2", scored at 4-1/4"
- Basic White: 5-1/4" x 6", scored at 2" and 4"
- Basic White: (2) 1/2" x 4", scored at 2"
- Flowering Fields Designer Series Paper: 4" x 5-1/4"
- Flowering Fields Designer Series Paper: (2) 1-3/4" x 5"

You can use any die cut shape to cut out the front opening. Make sure to only adhere the right side of the die cut to the inside "swing" portion of the card.



Daffodil Pinwheel Tower Card

- Mossy Meadow: 5" x 7", scored at 1/2", 1-1/2", 2-1/2", and 3-1/2"
- Mossy Meadow: (3) 3-1/2" x 5"
- Daffodil Afternoon Designer Series Paper: (4) 2-1/4" x 4-3/4"
- Daffodil Afternoon Designer Series Paper: (4) 3-1/4" x 4-3/4"

I used Very Vanilla, Mossy Meadow, Flirty Flamingo, Basic Black, and Petal Pink for the die cuts. The greeting was punched with the Label Me Fancy punch.

Tulip Pinwheel Tower Card

- Evening Evergreen: 5" x 7", scored at 1/2", 1-1/2", 2-1/2", and 3-1/2"
- Evening Evergreen: (3) 3-1/2" x 5"
- Flowering Fields Designer Series Paper: (4) 2-1/4" x 4-3/4"
- Flowering Fields Designer Series Paper: (4) 3-1/4" x 4-3/4"

For the die cuts, I used Poppy Parade, Calypso Coral, Whisper White, Rich Razzleberry, Highland Heather, Mango Melody, So Saffron, and Pear Pizzaz. The panel was embellished with Brass Butterflies and Evening Evergreen 3/8" Windowpane Check Ribbon.



Daffodil Concertina Card

- Very Vanilla: 6" x 10", scored at 5"
- Very Vanilla: 6" x 10-1/2", scored at 5" and 10"
- Very Vanilla: 3-1/2" x 11", scored at 1/2", 2", 5-1/2", 9", and 10-1/2"
- Very Vanilla: 2-1/4" x 2-1/4" (for greeting)
- Mossy Meadow: (5) 4-3/4" x 5-3/4"
- Mossy Meadow: (2) 3-1/4" x 3-1/4"
- Mossy Meadow: (2) 1-1/4" x 3-1/4"
- Daffodil Afternoon Designer Series Paper: (5) 4-1/2" x 5-1/2"
- Daffodil Afternoon Designer Series Paper: (2) 3" x 3"
- Daffodil Afternoon Designer Series Paper: (2) 1" x 3"

Use these measurements if you wish to have more layers on your card. For the die cuts, I used the following colors: Very Vanilla, Daffodil Delight, Flirty Flamingo, and Basic Black.



Tulip Concertina Card

- Poppy Parade: 6" x 10", scored at 5"
- Poppy Parade: 6" x 10-1/2", scored at 5" and 10"
- Poppy Parade: 3-1/2" x 11", scored at 1/2", 2", 5-1/2", 9", 10-1/2"
- Flowering Fields Designer Series Paper: (5) 4-3/4" x 5-3/4"
- Flowering Fields Designer Series Paper: (2) 3-1/4" x 3-1/4"
- Flowering Fields Designer Series Paper: (2) 1-1/4" x 3-1/4"

The card front was embellished with Brass Butterflies and Evening Evergreen 3/8" Windowpane Check Ribbon. I also added a 1-3/4" x 5-3/4" piece of Designer Series Paper to the front panel. Tulips and leaves were die cut from Poppy Parade, Calypso Coral, Petal Pink, Pear Pizzaz, and Evening Evergreen.
