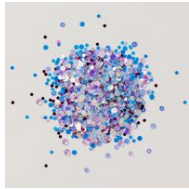

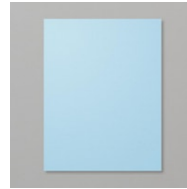

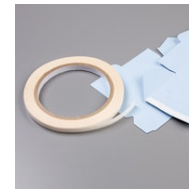

## Project Recipe:

1. Cut Beautiful Bokeh Designer Series Paper to 4" x 5-1/4"
2. Place paper into a clear envelope and tape along edge so it fits snugly.
3. Place some of the Itty Bitty Bokeh Mix inside the envelope, then seal it closed.
4. Place a generous amount of Tear & Tape adhesive on the back of the clear envelope. Remove backing and adhere to a 5-1/2" x 8-1/2" Balmy Blue card base that is folded in half.
5. Using the hybrid embossing folder, emboss and die cut a butterfly from the DSP. You will also need to die cut a detailed butterfly from Fresh Fesia cardstock, a body from Night of Navy cardstock, and a label from Basic White cardstock.
6. Adhere butterfly to card with dimensionals and liquid glue.
7. Stamp "happy birthday" in Berry Burst ink onto the Basic White label. Adhere to card with dimensionals.
8. Stamp a 4" x 5-1/4" piece of Basic White cardstock with butterflies and "time to celebrate" in Berry Burst ink. Adhere to the inside of the card.
9. Shake! Shake! Shake!
